1. WHAT PEPSANE, capsule IS AND WHAT IT IS USED FOR

ANTIACID

(A: Digestive system and metabolism) This medicine is used for the relief of acid regurgitation, heartburn and acid indigestion.

2. WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU TAKE PEPSANE, capsule

If your doctor told you that you have sugar intolerance, consult him/her before taking this medicine.

Do not take PEPSANE, capsule:

• if you are allergic (hypersensitive) to one of the ingredients. IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBTS, YOU MUST SEEK ADVICE FROM YOUR DOCTOR OR PHARMACIST.

Warnings and precautions

Warnings

If symptoms do not disappear within ten days, if the pain is associated with fever, vomiting, *YOU SHOULD CONSULT YOUR DOCTOR*.

Use of this medicine is not recommended in patients with fructose intolerance (rare hereditary disease).

Precautions

Avoid tobacco, alcoholic drinks, too spicy meal, stress, certain medications (aspirin, anti-inflammatory drugs) which can cause burning and hyperacidity.

IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBTS, DO NOT HESITATE TO ASK YOUR DOCTOR OR YOUR PHARMACIST FOR ADVICE.

Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or have recently taken any other medicines, including medicines obtained without a prescription.

Pregnancy and breast-feeding

This medicine may, in normal use conditions, be taken during pregnancy or while breast-feeding.

Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking any medicine.

Excipients with known effect: sorbitol.

3. HOW TO TAKE PEPSANE, CAPSULE

Dosage

Swallow with half a glass of water 1 capsule when the pain occurs.

It is usually unnecessary to exceed 4 capsules daily. If these are insufficient to calm you, *CONSULT YOUR DOCTOR*. **Method and route of administration**

Oral route.

If you take more PEPSANE, capsule than you should: Consult your doctor or pharmacist.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

Like all medicines, PEPSANE, capsule can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. Hypersensitivity reactions such as skin eruptions or pruritus have very rarely been reported.

Reporting of side effects

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor or pharmacist. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. You can also report side effects directly via the national reporting system: Agence nationale de sécurité du médicament et des produits de santé (ANSM) et réseau des Centres Régionaux de Pharmacovigilance - Website: www.ansm.sante.fr By reporting side effects you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

5. HOW TO STORE PEPSANE, capsule

Keep this medicine out of the sight and reach of children. Do not use PEPSANE, capsule after the expiry date which is stated on the carton.

Blister (PVC/PE/PVDC/aluminium): no special storage conditions.

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help protect the environment.
